On this 2nd day of October, 1964, the attorney for the government and the defendant appeared in person and without counsel; the court advised the defendant of his right to counsel and asked him whether he desired to have counsel appointed by the court, and the defendant thereupon stated that he waived the right to the assistance of counsel.

It is ADJUDGED that the defendant has been convicted upon his plea of Guilty of the offense of

Violation of Section 2312, Title 18, United States Code (Interstate transportation of stolen motor vehicle)

as charged in Count 1 of information and the court having asked the defendant whether he has anything to say why judgment should not be pronounced, and no sufficient cause to the contrary being shown or appearing to the Court,

It is ADJUDGED that the defendant is guilty as charged and convicted.

It is ADJUDGED that the defendant is hereby committed to the custody of the Attorney General or his authorized representative for imprisonment for a period of as provided in Title 18, United States Code, Section 4203(b) for a study, as described in Title 18, United States Code, Section 4203(c). This commitment shall be deemed to be for the maximum sentence of imprisonment prescribed by law.

It is ADJUDGED that

It is ORDERED that the Clerk deliver a certified copy of this judgment and commitment to the United States Marshal or other qualified officer and that the copy serve as the commitment of the defendant.
