Mrs. Hagemaster was very reluctant to discuss the Ray case with the below signed investigators, telling them that a court order had been issued about the case. It was pointed out to Mrs. Hagemaster that the order did not pertain to conversations with Attorneys or Investigators for both the State and the Defense, but only related to press releases and the like. Upon learning this Mrs. Hagemaster again declined comment saying she knew nothing about the case, but that she was on duty at the front desk during the evening and night of the period of time in question and she further stated that she was under subpoena as a State witness in the lawsuit under investigation. Mrs. Hagemaster declined comment about whether she could make any type of identification at all, although this investigator believes that she could not, this is based upon her statement about the number of people who stay at the motel and such, and also due to the fact that she stated she did not know anything about the case. Mrs. Hagemaster stated that she did talk to authorities for the State and Federal Government.
