Mr. Copeland stated to the below signed Investigators that she got off work at 4:30 PM on April 4, 1968 and was standing at the front window of Seabrook Paint Co., looking outside, when at about 4:40 PM she observed a small white car drive up and park at the curb just south of Canipe Amusement Co. This car was facing north, parked on the east side of Main St. Mrs. Copeland observed a white man get out of the drivers side, he had on a suit coat, she could remember nothing else about him or which way he went or anything else about this incident. She also was interviewed by the F B I and Police Authorities.
