420 So. Front St. Memphis, Tenn. Mr. Cupples stated that he went to Jims Grill on So. Main a little after 5 PM on April 4, 1968. He further stated that he noticed a white mustang parked at the curb, facing north in front of Jims Grill. He did not notice anything else about this automobile. He did not hear anything that sounded like a shot while in Jims Grill. He is uncertain about when it happened, but a Deputy Sheriff came to the door and told everyone to stay inside and not to leave. Mr. Cupples then looked out the window and noticed that the ^{north} white mustang was gone. He further stated that Officers got everyone in Jims Grill to write their name and address before they could leave, he said they were allowed to leave about 9 PM.
