Mrs. Short and her husband, who is Dock Foreman for Gordan Transports Inc. own the rooming house at 422 1/2 So. Main St.

Mrs. Short stated that she or her husband only went to the rooming house to collect the rent from the Resident Manager, Bessie Brewer, who is no longer with Mrs. Short. Mrs. Short stated that Bessie Brewer told her that the only thing she (Bessie Brewer) saw on April 4, 1968 when she rented the room, was a new \$20.00 bill and she did not notice anything else. Mrs. Short states that Bessie Brewer cannot be trusted. She further stated that Charles Stephens was untrustworthy and a complete drunk and that when he moved (at her request) he took a piece of furniture owned by her.

Mrs. Short stated that the only trustworthy person at the rooming house is Mr. Bertie Reeves, who is now in the Veterans Hospital in Memphis, that if anyone knows anything about the matter under investigation it would be Bertie Reeves.
