Mr. Walker stated that he was in Jims Grill on So. Main about 5:15 PM on April 4, 1968. He observed that all of the cars parked in the vicinity of Jims Grill were white and he does remember that a white Mustang was parked just a little north of the front of Jims Grill. This mustang was facing north, parked on the east side of Main St. Mr. Walker does not know, but at some time a Deputy Sheriff came in the door and told everyone to stay inside. Mr. Walker did not hear a shot or any unusual noise at anytime. He left after giving his name and address to officers. He ~~did~~ not pay any attention to when this white mustang left. He talked to F B I and Police authorities and he knows nothing else of this incident.
