Mr. Wood stated to the undersigned Investigators that he was formerly employed by Tayloe Paper Co. on So. Front St. He further stated that on April 4, 1968, shortly after 5 PM he went to Jims Grill on So. Main St. At the time of his entrance into the Grill he observed a white Mustang parked at the curb a little North of Jims Grill. This Mustang was parked between a Cadillac owned by Mr. Lloyd Jowers and a Lincoln automobile. The Lincoln was parked in front and the Cadillac was parked behind the Mustang. Mr. Wood did not remember the exact time, but a Deputy Sheriff came to the door and told everyone to stay inside and told the owner to lock the front door. Shortly after the Deputy left, Mr. Wood noticed that the white Mustang was gone. He has talked to the Attorney Generals Office and Police Authorities about what he knows. Mr. Wood heard no shot and observed nothing else.
