Interview with Mr. A. W. Wansley
Owner of Mineral Wells Motel, Mineral Wells, Mississippi

The undersigned investigators received information that James Earl Ray or someone using one of his aliases stayed the night of Apr. 2, 1968 at a motel just across the state line in Miss. This motel was alleged to fly the Rebel flag.

Mr. Wansley owner of this motel stated that he had no flag pole and had never flown the Rebel flag and that he had no over night guests on that night nor had he checked any person into the motel who might have been the party in question.

Mr. Wansley stated that he knew Mr. Foreman, that years ago they attended the same small church in Houston, Tex.
