At approximately 3:00 PM, January 29, 1969, Sheriff Morris received an anonymous phone call from subject who sounded like a male white. This subject said, "I can tell you who was driving the white Mustang on 51 north the night King was killed. He said the reason that he would not identify himself was because he was fearful of his life, but if the information he was going to give us checked out and found to be correct that he would call back and give us his name.

The subject said that the driver of the white Mustang was a Bob Sanders and worked at the Tipton County Hospital in Covington, Tennessee. He said that Sanders had sold the Mustang and that this information had come from Sanders' Supervisor a Mrs. Nelson and that Mrs. Nelson was the one who was telling this information to people.

This letter is being written at the direction of the Sheriff and is for your information and possible action.
