

OPPORTUNISTS FAIL IN MISERABLE ATTEMPT TO LIKEN  
ASSASSINATION OF KING TO CRUCIFIXION OF CHRIST!

Dear Concerned American:

There is no doubt but what The President's Commission on Civil Disorders did a disservice to the American people by seeking to divide this nation into two categories, and as a direct result of that infamous Kerner report, any number of Whites and Blacks have been murdered, including that self-styled and self-appointed civil rights leader Martin Luther King.

The statement of the Kerner report to the effect that they had found no conspiracy in studying the riots of 1967, is totally unacceptable to me and many others who have not ceased day or night during the past several years to warn the American people that there is very definitely a conspiracy, deep and dangerous, designed to demoralize the nation, to divide it, and if possible, to conquer it.

Many of our high officials are willingly ignorant of what is going on, and many of our very fine American citizens have eyes to see and see not only because they do not wish to see, however, if the blind lead the blind, both shall fall into a ditch and be destroyed.

The Kerner report and our federal government not only helped King fan the flames of racial hate, but they seem unalterably dedicated to the same insidious goal, --- that of completing the destruction of the American form of government to the jubilation of Marxists everywhere.

A day of mourning for Martin Luther King was observed, when it should have been a day of prayer for our once-great Republic which now lies critically wounded - perhaps on its death bed, thanks to the tireless efforts of such men as the late Martin Luther King.

But no; our hypocritical, opportunistic, leadership must attempt to canonize --- make a saint of one of the most devout enemies the American, Christian, free, initiative system ever had, and one of the most dedicated friends the communists ever had.

Apparently King in death is going to accomplish more, more quickly, than King alive and kicking could have achieved in a normal lifetime.

What is there about the make up of human nature that makes a citizen in the American society of the 20th Century turn a knob to lock out all the bad in a man - simply because he has gone to face the final judgment? A number of editors and other individuals who had been lambasting King somewhat furiously only a few days before the assassin struck - did an about face and wrote stirring eulogies to the "Great Man" that you have ever witnessed .... because now the man was dead!

When a man dies .... must it be forgotten that through reverse psychology with the insincere cry of "non violence" he has created perhaps more violence over race relations than any other American who ever lived, including Rap Brown and Stokely Carmichael?

When a man dies .... must we forget that he had questionable ties with international enemies of this country - like at the Highlander Folk School in Monteagle, Tennessee, and more later?

When a man dies .... must an order be issued from the White House for all flags to be lowered to half-mast as a symbol of mourning for one who consistently flouted what that flag represents namely; LAW and ORDER? (All who refused to lower their flags to half-mast are to be commended, and this included the Governor of Georgia, Dow Chemical Company of Torrance, California, and many, many others.)

When a man dies .... does this demand that the President who was about to ask this man to reconsider his proposed poor people's campaign and march on Washington, D. C., now joins hands with other "instant" worshippers in praise of this man?

When a man dies .... must our weak-kneed political office holders and office seekers only for political expediency vie with one another to see which one could eulogize him the loudest and longest - thus trying to use him in death as some had used him in life --- while others shed crocodile tears and pretended to be sad and sorrowful in their attempt to appease and pacify black people because they were afraid of what the consequences might be as a result of the assassination?

When a man dies . . . . must the President then postpone for days - maybe disastrously - the one chance he has had to talk with the enemy about stopping a war that is costing thousands of deaths to American boys, turning his back on the soldiers and their families?

When one Black man dies . . . . must the whole country overlook another incident where a White man had his intestines cut out on the streets of Washington, D. C. by a black gang; and forget all the other Whites beaten and killed?

When a Black man dies in this society of ours . . . . must we forget that he made a good living helping our enemies stir up strife between the races -- and that this is the only job at which he was ever successful?

When a man gets shot in Memphis . . . . does nobody reflect that he who has caused so much violence is now reaping what he sowed?

Don't misunderstand! I am sorry that Dr. King was shot! No more sorry than about each of the others who have died in retaliation. No more sorry than about each soldier, Black or White, who dies daily in Vietnam. But sorry. Aside from the fact that King was a human being (a human, not a saint) who was viciously murdered, this particular murder was bad for our country.

Because now there will be another "Civil Rights" bill - broader and stronger and more pro-Negro than any that could possibly have passed the Congress without the murder. The "King Bill" passed on a wave of sympathy and guilt will give more power to those agitators posing as crusaders. Civil rights bills only serve to inflame the people. All we need is the Constitution that guarantees the same everything to Whites and Blacks alike!

I am also sorry because this shooting gives ban-the-gun advocates in and out of Congress yet another excuse to try for legislation that would disarm American citizens . . . . and this time it may pass.

I am sorry because it exposed our country's leaders as stupes enough to help make a martyr out of a man who had blood on his hands - blood spattered from Selma, Alabama across the country through other population centers to Washington, D. C. . . . much more blood than on the hands of the man who killed him. The President is scared to death of the Negro rebellion he has helped to create. And he should be. Like Frankenstein's monster, it may destroy its creator. (And there are still other ambitious candidates who think the Negro can elect them President.)

A word of caution. Let no one overlook the fact that the new leadership which has succeeded King has set out to out-King --- King, and literally, millions of dollars are already pouring into their coffers to assist them in the effort, consequently, this means that we of the Constructive, Christian, Conservative, Patriotic persuasion really have our work all cut out for us.

My actions in behalf of understanding during this most crucial period in our country's domestic history has cost me dearly in persecution, intimidation, threats, physical assaults, etc., on both myself and members of my family (wife and six children) all because I am an American, Southern-born Negro interested in and fighting for constitutional government, states' sovereignty and our basic heritage; and I do have and deliver a message of TRUTH and AMERICANISM as seen and interpreted by an American Negro!

I am the founder and executive director of the DEDICATED INDEPENDENT SOCIETY COMMITTEE AGAINST RACIAL DEMONSTRATIONS, INC., America's one and only 100 percent anti-demonstration organization which was incorporated November 19, 1963, and known in its abbreviated form as DISCARD, INC.

I humbly solicit the prayerful, moral and financial support of all interested persons as I continue my efforts in such a manner as to reflect the true good will of the people of this country as they rise to preserve our governmental structure.
