

GERMANTOWN CEMETERY

Visited November 1, 1969. Located opposite 7491 McVay Road. The cemetery was so greatly overgrown and in such poor condition that many stones may have been covered. The cemetery was said to be near the site of an early Methodist Church.

DUKE-MOORE CEMETERY

Visited January 15, 1970. This family cemetery was located a half mile from the highway behind 6766 Poplar Pike (Highway 70) on property now belonging to Mrs. Henry Wetter. The cemetery was in a grove of cedar and other large trees, and the ground was covered with ivy and vines. Vandals and time have damaged the stones. The grave of Britton Duke had recently been dug out to a depth of four or five feet for some unknown purpose. There were at least fifteen graves, each enclosed with a concrete border, but only the following three had inscribed stones:
