

TABERNACLE HILL or PIPERTON CEMETERY

This cemetery is located near Collierville, Tennessee, on the north side of U.S. Highway 57, about 100 yards east of the Shelby County line in Fayette County. It has been cleared of all undergrowth and is well kept. Most of the stones appear to be in place, but at one place along the west fence and at another place near a tree toward the back of the cemetery, a number of "loose" stones have been piled. These were separated for copying the inscriptions, and broken stones were pieced together with all parts that could be found. Mrs. James Russell, 506 Peterson Lake Road, Collierville, helped greatly in locating and copying these inscriptions. Visited November 2, 1969.
