

PLEASANT RIDGE METHODIST CHURCH CEMETERY

Visited November 11, 1969. Located behind Pleasant Ridge Methodist Church, 7499 Pleasant Ridge Road, Arlington, Tennessee 38002. The cemetery was well kept, and effort had obviously been made to restore broken monuments. On the step of the back door entrance of the Church was the following inscription:
