ROBINSON CEMETERY

Visited November 11, 1969. This much neglected and densely overgrown cemetery was located in a grove of trees across the road from a home at 8380 Deadfall Road, about a fourth mile north of Godwin Road and east of Highway 14 (Austin Peay). Mrs. Victor Ludric Faulk, 8538 Deadfall Road, said there had been six gravestones in the cemetery, but remnants of only four could be found.

HILL-TROBAUGH-BARNETT or BETHEL CHURCH CEMETERY

Visited June 4, 1969, and February 20, 1970. Located about 400 yards behind a home at 9019 Deadfall Road. Charles L. Faulk, 8916 Deadfall Road, is a son of Mrs. Victor Ludric Faulk (see above Robinson Cemetery) and a descendant of the Faulk, Pinkston and Robbins families who owned land on both sides of Deadfall Road. Other descendants live in Shelby County and adjoining Tipton County. The area was heavily overgrown on the first visit, but all stones were upright. On the second visit, the area had been cleared and all stones, except one, knocked over. Brick-covered graves and parts of other stones could be seen. The old Bethel Church was said to have been located off a road which went through this cemetery to Mudville.
