

SHELBY FOREST BAPTIST CHURCH CEMETERY

Visited January 25 and February 1, 1970. Located on the south side of Cuba-Locke Road about a fourth mile east of Locke, Tennessee. The first church established on this site was said to have been Presbyterian, and the cemetery was known as Old Union Cemetery. There are presently two cemetery areas. The older, behind the present church building, is believed to be Old Union, while a newer cemetery directly west of the church is used as a community cemetery. The older area is somewhat neglected, but appears to have been cleared during the last year. Due to the heavy cover of leaves, many fallen stones may have been overlooked by the compilers. The stones copied there were widely separated, and many sunken places indicated many unmarked graves. The newer area is well kept. Burials in the older area dated from 1843 to about the turn of the century and are marked below by an asterik.
