

GRATITUDE METHODIST CHURCH CEMETERY

Visited December 2, 1972. This cemetery is located at the corner of Millington-Arlington and Gratitude Church Roads, about four miles from both the Fayette and Tipton County lines, in the northeast corner of Shelby County. No cornerstone was found on the present church building. The earliest marked burial found was dated in 1850. The cemetery is primarily well-kept, but two or three single graves are heavily overgrown, while almost all footstones have been removed from their original sites and placed in out-of-the-way places, presumably to aid in cemetery maintenance.
