NOTES - PISGAH CEMETERY (Pages 90-104 of Volume I)

The John Everett Allen Family Cemetery was located at 4281 Covington Pike, near Egypt, Tennessee, and was moved into Pisgah Cemetery. The first ten Allen inscriptions on Page 90 represent those moved. There is also a stone for Rose Mary Allen, but she is not known to be related to the others. John Owen Allen, son of John Everett Allen, lives at the family homeplace and gave the information. John Everett Allen and Hugh H. Allen, who married Effie M. _____, were brothers. John Everett Allen married Lucy Eddins, and they were the parents of four children:
