Articles in The Commercial Appeal of May 4, and May 19, 1970, and in The Press-Scimitar of May 19, and June 12, 1970, reported the discovery of an Egyptian mummy-case-type coffin near Kate Bond Road in Shelby County. The remains of a man, tentatively identified as Thomas Harwell, were inside. Thomas Harwell, a native of Virginia, died in Shelby County, ca. 1854, aged about 72 years. This body was re-buried in Morning Sun Cemetery, with a new tombstone showing those data.
