

DEADERICK FAMILY CEMETERY

Visited November 2, 1975. This small cemetery is located on Park Avenue, on the north side of the street, about 100 feet east of Grand Street. A low stone wall is on the street side. The remains of a cyclone wire fence surround the area. The cemetery is heavily overgrown and littered with trash. Two large monuments are located there. Both have fallen to the ground.
