

NEW SALEM CUMBERLAND PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH CEMETERY

Visited October 20 and 27, 1973. This cemetery is located southeast of Bolton, Tennessee, about a half mile south of the intersection of Pleasant Ridge and Salem roads on the west side of Salem Road. The condition of the cemetery was deceptive. It appeared to be a well kept area, but the compilers found need for extensive probing and digging to uncover many of the older inscriptions shown below. Over the years, many stones had fallen and were completely covered by rooted grass. No estimate can be made of the remaining covered stones in the area. The earliest marked graves were for 1846

A plaque on the front of the church building had the following data: "New Salem Cumberland Presbyterian Church - Rebuilt Sept. 1942 - Rev. Wilson D. Keenan, Pastor & Building Committee: N.C. Carruthers - Mrs. Emma Douglas - W.G. Herring - R.B. Stewart" Three members of the church who visited the cemetery while the compilers were there said (1) the original church building was about 100 years old when the present building was erected, (2) Mr. Will Sessum who died in 1969, age 96, was the only person who knew where every burial in the cemetery was located, and (3) part of the land for the church and cemetery was given by the McCaughy family.

MOUNT VERNON UNITED METHODIST CHURCH CEMETERY

Visited October 12, 1974. This fairly well-kept cemetery is located at 5790 Benjestown Road at Fite Road, in the northwestern area of the county. There are large open spaces within the cemetery. The Rev. Edna Thornton is the present pastor of the Church. Her husband, the Rev. Elwood Thornton, retired, told the compilers the church was organized about 1870, and part of the present 7 1/2 acres of property was received from H.B. Ramsey. The 1888 map shows H.B. Ramsey with 647.16 acres of land, plus other acreage, in this area next to B. Bateman. The earliest marked burial found was dated in 1872. The cornerstone of the church: Mt. Vernon M.E. Church 1950. The compilers were told that there were other tombstones across Fite Road behind an old home on the corner, but two searches of the area found no stones.
