

DAVIS - BOWE - McCARGO CEMETERY

Visited July 3, 1976. Only a few stones were located on the east side of Tchulahoma Road, 0.7 mile south of Shelby Drive inside a newly developed subdivision with paved streets, gutters, sidewalks and houses under construction. The immediate area has no houses, is on top of a high spot with three large trees, on Cloudland Drive, 0.2 miles east of intersection with Morningview Drive. Entrance to the subdivision from Tchulahoma Road is just south of this place, onto Morning Wind Drive.

TINSLEY DAVIS FAMILY CEMETERY

In the cemetery above called Davis - Bowe - McCargo by the compilers, only a few gravestones were found but in 1970 Mrs. Doris Davis Meux, great-great-granddaughter of Tinsley Davis, contributed a list of those who are buried in this family cemetery. There are a few variations in the notations.

Tinsley Davis, son of John Dabney and Anne Ragland (Tinsley) Davis, was born in Hanover County, Virginia. His first wife was Frances Ragland, daughter of Beverly and Rebecca (Bowe) Ragland. They married April 15, 1813, moved to Kentucky in 1814, and to Limestone County, Alabama in 1817. Frances Ragland Davis died February 22, 1822. Tinsley Davis returned to Virginia and
