

ELLIS BURYING GROUND - TOLL GATE CEMETERY

The Toll Gate Cemetery appears in V.II, pp.328-329. Evidently this ground was part of the Robert Ellis plantation. He was the son of Jesse and Lucy Ellis, who came from Virginia in the early 1830's. Robert was one of the older children. He married Mary E. Cross and their tall two-story home sat on the south side from the cemetery, which was known later as the Schwamm Place.

The Toll Gate name was added because a toll-gate was operated on the highway below the rise on which the graveyard stands. All the graves are not marked but the names of some of those were acquired from Mrs. Irene Ellis Riggins. Additions and variations to the Toll Gate Cemetery in Volume II p.328 are:
