NAMES OF ARRESTING OFFICERS

On Thursday, April 4, 1968, at 7:00 p.m., Manuel Levin was offered the use of the telephone, at which time he did complete a phone call to Attorney R. V. Taffee, at 609-4444, and did sign the proper phone slips to this effect, which was witnessed by Lt. E. Ross and B. E. Lightfoot, copies of same are hereto attached.

Levin was arrested with Alex Jay Hurder, MW, 22, after a broadcast had been put out, after the shooting of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., at the Lorraine Motel, that two male whites were seen changing clothes in a garage on Second Street and Pentecost,

Investigation by Lt. W. S. Schultz and FBI Agent, Joe Hester, revealed that Levin and Hurder had just left the Electric Waffle Shop on S. Main, after having dinner, and had heard the police cars, answering the call to the Lorraine Motel, and that these two male whites joined a crowd of reporters. After leaving the motel, they were arrested at Second and Vance, as two male whites fitting the description of the subjects changing clothes. The informer who notified the police department, of the two subjects changing clothes, was not identified. After it was found that Levin and Hurder had nothing to do with the murder of King, they were released.
