It is ADJUDGED that the defendant is hereby committed to the custody of the Attorney General or his authorized representative for imprisonment for a period of

five (5) years in an institution to be designated by the Attorney General.

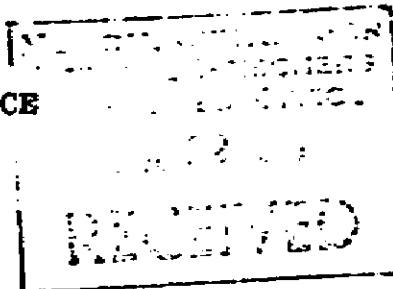

ORDER TO WARDEN
