Roma Amor

An essay on erotic elements in Etruscan and Roman art, involving primarily sexual, hermaphroditic and priapic imagery. Many photos in full page color. Direct reproductions from frescoes, walls of ancient Pompeii and so-called "secret museums," now considered presentable after hundreds of years of suppression.

Subjects pictured include: rape, seduction, coitus, troilism, females as aggressors phallicism (statues and paintings of

men and satyrs in various erotic acts— with erections, en coitu with both female and sympha, acts of seduction, homosexuality, etc.), phallic elements—uteri, amulets, coins, etc., bestiality; statues of satyrs with gigantic erections, etc.

Eros Kalos

An essay on erotic elements in Greek art. By Jean Marcade professor of Archeology, University of Bordeaux, France. As with most early civilizations, the sexual element is woven throughout all Greek life. Eros Kalos reveals this in its drawings, friezes, statues, pottery, coins, etc., reproduced here from leading museums of the world. Many pages in color.

Subjects include: bestiality (both male and female), erotic dances, masturbation practiced by both sexes, animal intercourse, satyrs and mortals with excessive

penes, sexual intercourse involving men and women as well as satyrs and sympha in all common postural variations as well as soixante-neuf activities, homosexuality, huge phallic statues and cunnus emblems, women performing intimate toilet rites, pluralism, pre-coital scenes, women with huge artificial phalluses, fellation, use of artificial penes, phallic worship, phallic pottery, troilism (two men and a woman engaged en coitu), etc.

Masturbation — childhood experiments, lesbian practices, prevalence, techniques.

Oral Intercourse — childhood experiments, homosexual and heterosexual activities, prevalence, techniques, quotations from Chinese erotica involving fellation/cunnilingus, soixante-neuf relations. \$5.95.
