OUTLIP FIRE CONTENT

Mr. Foster stated to the undersigned Investigators that on April 4, 1968, at about 5:05 PM or 5:10 PM he went to Jims Grill on So. Main St. He stated further that while playing the shuffleboard game a Deputy Sheriff came to the door of Jims Grill and told everyone to stay inside, he did not know what time of day this took place.

Mr. Foster also stated that when he went inside Jims Grill he noticed a white Mustang parked in front of or just to the North of Jims Grill, this car was at the East curb, facing North. Mr. Foster heard no shot and did not observe anything further, except that when he looked out the front window after the Deputy ordered everyone to stay there, that the white Mustang was gone.
