Report on Investigation of Ray Case

The undersigned investigators, upon information furnished to Hugh Stanton Jr. by Renfro Hayes, went to the Ambassador Hotel on So. Main St., the Tri-State Hotel on So. Main St., the Clark Hotel at Vance and So. Main and the Ponotoc Hotel on Ponotoc St.

The information of Hayes was to the effect that a blond male, white 25 to 30 years old stayed one or two nights in one of these Hotels under the name of Willard or Sneyd, alias alleged to have been used by James Earl Ray. This man was alleged to have stayed sometime between April 1, 1968 and April 5, 1968.

The records of the above mentioned Hotels reveal that no such man checked into any of these establishments about that time.
